**Who:** Students Ages 14 – 18

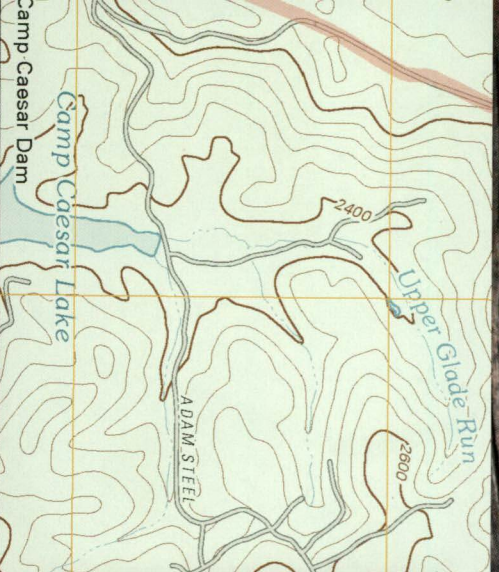
**Where:** Camp Caesar in Webster County

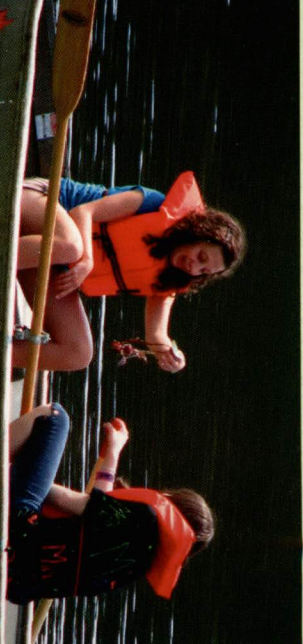

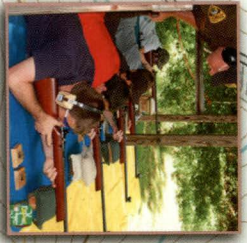
